Nut Free School

Can we please remind all parents that Udny Green School is a <u>nut free school</u>. It is important that no child takes nuts, or food items containing nuts, to school as the airborne particles can cause severe reactions.

School Uniform.

It's great to see so many of our pupils looking really smart in their school uniform. A reminder that our uniform consists of black, grey or navy trousers, shorts and skirts along with a white or bottle green polo shirt and a school sweatshirt, cardigan or fleece. Checked summer dresses are also permitted. Jogging bottoms should be kept as part of the PE kit and not worn as school uniform.

Please ensure **all** school uniform, PE kits and water bottles are clearly marked with your child's name.

PE KITs

All pupils will require to have a PE kit in school as we will continue to provide two weekly sessions of PE for each class. When possible, these sessions will take place outside, but as the weather changes they may have to be held in the multi-purpose hall.

PE kits should contain:

- Shorts, jogging bottoms/leggings
- T-shirts and sweatshirt for outdoors
- Socks (tights should not be worn)
- Appropriate footwear gym shoes for indoors and trainers for outdoors
- All girls with long hair should have a bobble to tie up their hair
- No jewellery

Indoor Shoes and Change of Clothes



Please ensure that all children have an indoor pair of shoes to change into when they arrive at school, after breaks and for

PE. We would recommend that all pupils have a change of clothes, including waterproof jacket for outdoor learning.

Water Bottles

Please ensure your child has a water bottle with them every day, clearly marked with their name. These can be topped up at the water fountain throughout the school day.



Free School Meals for Primary 6 & 7 pupils



The Scottish Government has paused the roll out of free school meals to all Primary 6 and Primary 7 pupils.

The government's decision was made to allow further work with COSLA, the national association of Scottish councils, and all local authorities to fully assess the financial and infrastructure challenges that have been highlighted for the final phase of the expansion plans. We will be in touch with further information when a decision is taken by the government to progress the roll-out to all Primary 6 and Primary 7 pupils.
