

Outdoor Clothing

PE KITs




All pupils should have a PE kit in school as we will continue to provide two weekly sessions of PE for each class.

- Appropriate footwear gym shoes for indoors and trainers for outdoors
- All girls with long hair should have a bobble to tie up their hair
- No jewellery
