Techfest



New Primary 1 Pupils - Transition Dates




We are delighted to be welcoming 7 new pupils into Primary 1 after summer. Transition dates for the pupils will be:


P7 Pupils - Meldrum Academy Transition

REMINDERS

Absent Pupils

Can we please ask that, if your child is off sick or cannot come to school due to adverse weather/road conditions, you call or email the school to let us know. This will enable us to update our records without having to contact you to find out where your child is. As we keep registers that are shared with the Scottish Government is important that absences are recorded correctly

Outdoor Clothing

With the weather still on the wintery side, can we please remind you of the importance of appropriate outdoor clothing. Please ensure your child has a waterproof jacket and warm clothing, including hats and gloves, for outdoor play as we will be outside at break and lunch times as much as possible. Our school wellies are always available and easy to access at break and lunch times as well.

Water Bottles

Pupils should take a water bottle with them every day, clearly marked with their name.

These can be topped up at the water fountain throughout the school day.

PE KITs

All pupils should have a PE kit in school as we will continue to provide two weekly sessions of PE for each class. When possible, these sessions will take place outside

PE kits should contain:

- Shorts, jogging bottoms/leggings
- T-shirts and sweatshirt for outdoors
- Socks (tights should not be worn)
- Appropriate footwear gym shoes for indoors and trainers for outdoors
- All girls with long hair should have a bobble to tie up their hair
- No jewellery

If you have any old PE kit that you can donate to the school for use by other pupils, we would be very grateful.

Indoor Shoes and Change of Clothes



Please ensure that all children have an indoor pair of shoes to change into when they arrive at school, after breaks and for

PE. We would recommend that all pupils have a change of clothes, including waterproof jacket for outdoor learning.
