Literacy

In writing our focus is on information writing which includes reports and instructions.

In reading we will be enjoying exploring new books and having protected time to read books of our choice.

In listening and talking we will be encouraged to listen to what others are saying and extend the discussion.

Numeracy

In our number work we are learning to estimate and round both whole and decimal numbers. We will work on number word problems with more than one step and think carefully about the different strategies we can use to solve these. We will continue to practise our times tables daily.

In other areas of numeracy we are learning about measurement (length, capacity, area) and then we will move onto learn about shape.

Health and Wellbeing

We will be building our fitness in P.E. through circuits and monitoring our improving physical health.

In addition to this we are also improving our ball skills, using different passing techniques, dribbling, and shooting at a target through basketball.

Other Curricular Areas

This term our context for learning is 'Our Body'. We will be learning about our sensory organs such as our eyes and ears. We will also be learning about our internal systems such as our digestive system and nervous system.

In French we will be learning about names for our family members. We will practise greeting each other and telling people our names, asking for names and talking about where we live.

In Art we are linking activities to our body topic. We are creating detailed oil pastel pictures of an eye. We will also be producing sketches of human skulls which will be finished off using pointillism in neon colours in time for Halloween.
