REMINDERS

Allergy Advice

Can we please remind all parents that Udny Green School is a <u>nut free school</u>. It is important that no child takes nuts, or food items containing nuts, to school as the airborne particles can cause severe reactions.

Homework

Homework will continue to be issued in homework jotters and should be completed weekly. Activities can be completed in the jotter or photographs of activities can be taken and submitted through Learning Journals. Please remember to return homework jotters and reading books to school each week on the day advised by class teachers.

Appropriate Outdoor Clothing

As the weather is ever changeable, can we please ask that all pupils have a waterproof jacket with them every day. We would also ask that pupils have hats, gloves and scarfs as well as suitable outdoor footwear.

Indoor Shoes and Change of Clothes

All children should have an indoor pair of shoes to change into when they arrive at school, after breaks and for PE. These do not have to be expensive shoes or trainers, a simple pair of "gym shoes" is ideal. We would recommend that all pupils have a change of clothes, including waterproof jacket for outdoor learning.

Please ensure all school uniform, PE kits and water bottles are clearly marked with your child's name.

PE Kit

All pupils will require to have a PE kit in school as we will continue to provide two weekly sessions of PE for each class.

PE kits should contain:

- · Shorts, jogging bottoms/leggings
- T-shirts and sweatshirt for outdoors
- Socks (tights should not be worn)
- Appropriate footwear gym shoes for indoors and trainers for outdoors
- All pupils with long hair should have a bobble to tie up their hair
- No jewellery if earrings cannot be removed, they must be taped.

Water Bottles

Please ensure your child has a water bottle with them every day, clearly marked with their name. These can be topped up at the water fountain throughout the school day.
